



## ADOPTER AMENDMENT FOR GVIF EXTENSIONS

The Digital Content Protection, L.L.C. ("Licensor") is the authorized licensor of that certain proprietary technology for high-bandwidth digital content protection for the purposes of enabling a protected, interoperable video connection between certain digital devices and digital display monitors to allow display of such content while inhibiting copying ("HDCP"). Licensor and the Adopter identified on the signature page below ("Adopter") have entered into an HDCP License Agreement (the "HDCP License Agreement") pursuant to which Licensor granted certain licenses to Adopter to enable Adopter to create and distribute certain devices that integrate all or part of the HDCP specification. Licensor and Adopter now desire to modify and extend the terms of the HDCP License Agreement in accordance with the terms and conditions set forth below.

### AGREEMENT

In consideration of the covenants and agreements herein, each of Licensor and Adopter hereby agrees as follows:

1. This Adopter Amendment for GVIF Extensions modifies the terms and conditions of the HDCP License Agreement. All capitalized terms not otherwise defined in this letter shall have the meanings given them in the HDCP License Agreement.
2. The HDCP License Agreement is hereby revised as follows:
  - A. A new definition 1.27a is added to read as follows:

**"GVIF Extensions to HDCP"** means the specification entitled "Gigabit Video InterFace (GVIF) Extensions to HDCP Content Protection Specification, Release 1.1" (including the "Errata" thereto), as such specification may be amended from time to time pursuant to Section 5.
  - B. Definition 1.32 is revised to read as follows:

**"HDCP Specification"** means the specification entitled "HDCP Content Protection Specification, Release 1.1" (including the "Errata" thereto), as well as the GVIF Extensions to HDCP, as any of such specifications may be amended from time to time pursuant to Section 5.
  - C. Section 2 of Exhibit C (the "Compliance Rules") is revised to read as follows:

**2. Interoperability.** Licensed Products shall be constructed to support full interoperability by fully implementing either: (i) all mandatory aspects of the Digital Visual Interface Revision 1.0, as of April 2, 1999 (or such later version as may be in effect at the time of Adopter's design of the Licensed Products) ("DVI"), with the exception of those aspects expressly identified as optional or informative; or (ii) all mandatory aspects of the High Definition Multimedia Interface Revision 1.0, as of 02 April, 1999 ("HDMI"), with the exception of those HDMI aspects expressly identified as optional or informative; or (iii) both (i) and (ii) above; or (iv) all mandatory aspects of the GVIF Interface Revision 1.0, as of May 18, 2006 ("GVIF"), with the exception of those GVIF aspects expressly identified as optional or informative; provided, however, that in the case of subsection (iv), a product is a Licensed Product solely to the extent that it is: (a) designed (considering, e.g. size, form factor, ruggedness, power) for physical integration into a motor vehicle, (b) sold through channels in which such physical integration into a motor vehicle is standard practice, and either (c-1) designed (considering, e.g. size, form factor, ruggedness, power) and intended to receive or output HDCP Content over GVIF only while physically integrated into a motor vehicle or (c-2) designed so that in the event it is receiving or outputting HDCP Content while not physically integrated into a motor vehicle, it must receive or output HDCP Content in accordance with the requirements of subsection (i) or (ii) or (iii) above. Licensed Products and Licensed Source Components shall not apply HDCP encryption to Audiovisual Content transmitted to outputs other than DVI or HDMI outputs, or as permitted, GVIF outputs. HDCP shall not be implemented in any Licensed Product or Licensed Source Component in a manner so as to cause such Licensed Product or any Licensed Product incorporating such Licensed Source Component to be non-interoperable with other Licensed Products; provided, however, that (A) a Licensed Product with an HDMI output need not be compatible with a Licensed Product with a DVI input for any functionality other than video services, solely to the extent that such HDMI output functionality is not compatible with such DVI input functionality, and (B) a Licensed Product or Licensed Source Component with a DVI output need not be compatible with a Licensed Product or Licensed Source Component with an HDMI input for any functionality other than video services, solely to the extent that such DVI output functionality is not compatible with such HDMI input functionality. For avoidance of doubt, the interoperability requirement in the foregoing sentence (x) shall apply whether the Licensed Products or Licensed Source Components in question implement DVI, HDMI, or any combination thereof, and (y) shall not be construed to mean that GVIF input/output in the Licensed Products or Licensed Source Components must interoperate with HDMI or DVI input/output in the other Licensed Products or Licensed Source Components. For further clarification the design requirement in (a) and (c-1) above shall not require GVIF to be electrically disabled.

D. Section 1.2a of Exhibit A (the "Procedural Appendix") is added to read as follows:

1.2a **GVIF Device Key Fees.** In addition to the Annual Fee, Adopter shall pay the following GVIF Device Key Fees for each order of GVIF Device Key Sets:

| <u>Number of Device Key Sets</u> | <u>Fee per Order</u> |
|----------------------------------|----------------------|
| 5,000,000                        | US \$20,000          |
| 1,000,000                        | US \$10,000          |
| 100,000                          | US \$7,500           |
| 10,000                           | US \$5000            |

3. Except as set forth herein, the terms and conditions of the HDCP License Agreement shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
